Call to Order - Meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by President Pam Ziegler

The following announcements were made:

Black History Month - The reception will be held at 2:00 PM, Sunday, February 21. The artist, Gwendolyn Campbell-Johnson, will be presented with a gift card as a thank you gift. Immediately after the presentation, the Buffalo Soldiers will begin. Beverley Hammond has been asked to prepare the food for the reception. A menu proposal will be presented at the next meeting for the Council's approval. Approximately 175 people are expected to attend. Heavy Hors d'oeuvres and punch will be served.

Book Fest - This event is scheduled for April 9, 2016. Sandy Garber will call Marilyn Jones at the Library to set a date for a meeting. The entertainment has already been scheduled. The Bright Star Touring Theatre group will be asked if the magician can use their sound system for his performance. This will eliminate time to take down and set up an additional sound system. Former authors have asked to have time and space to read from their books. This will be done this year. Last year's authors will be contacted by e-mail next week to ask if they want to exhibit again this year. Two weeks after the e-mail goes out, a media release will invite authors of children's books to exhibit this year. There are 26 pop-up tents available. If people want to bring their tent, tables and chairs, they may do so. If authors choose this option, they will not be charged the exhibitor's fee.

Art Cases - Beverley Hammond has volunteered her Nutcracker Collection for the cases during November and December.

Art Show Judges - Nancy Wentz asked for suggestions for judges for the Arts Council art shows. Several members gave suggestions and Nancy will follow up.

Nancy Wentz moved to adjourn and Beverley Hammond seconded the motion.
